### WELCOME BACK

Little progress was made on repairing cracks on our courts in 2014. Our court contractor invited Danny and I to observe a new method of repair in progress at the St James Tennis Club. This method uses a number of thin layers of fibreglass to cover filled cracks and appears to work well. We will check again in the spring to see how the repair survived the winter. If we proceed with this method the courts will have to be closed for a few days, when the weather is good.

You also have a special responsibility, under the honour system of unsupervised play, if you are the last person to leave the Club, to ensure that:

- 1) the court lights are turned off;
- 2) the gates and clubhouse are locked, and
- 3) the \$5.00 guest fee is paid by you or your guest (box on desk by kitchen door)
